RULES AND REGULATIONS 2023-2024 SEASON Administrators: Bishop Brossart High School Newport Central Catholic High School

This basketball league is formed by the Catholic High Schools of Campbell County to foster the following in the Catholic Grade Schools of the county.

- The opportunity to develop and express increased dedication to Church and school by players, parents, and spectators.
- The opportunity to further the development of cooperative spirit and the discipline required for this group sport.
- The opportunity to learn and use fundamental skills of the sport through organized league competition.
- IV. The opportunity to see the advantages of continuing their education on the high school level at either Bishop Brossart or Newport Central Catholic.

League Administration

The principal from each catholic high school in Campbell County shall name two representatives to oversee the league as commissioners and shall appoint a site director at their school. These directors shall administer the operations of the league at their site. Directors may appoint an "officials coordinator" to handle weekly assignment of game officials. Commissioners shall meet each year to set fees, rules, schedule dates and formats, awards, and discuss policies and/or league concerns

League By-Laws

1. Each team shall consist of no less than ten nor more than twenty players.

2. No school shall have more than two teams in each major division. Any school placing two teams within this league the entire combined rosters within each division must consist of eligible 7th and 8th grade students. The stronger team must play in the upper division. All other teams will have an option of which bracket within a division they wish to compete, with the league reserving the right of final placement to ensure balance and parity within the league.

3. Each player must be certified by the school principal that the player is passing in three-fourths of their subjects and are eligible to represent that school.

4. If a player does not attend the grade school they represent, a school representative must appear before the league executive committee to explain the situation.

5. Eligibility to a team is based on age. The player may not be (15) years old before September 1st of the current season & must be enrolled in a grade school.

6. Each team must submit an official roster at https://www.campbellcatholicleague.org/

7. Each player's Parent's Agreement Form must be to the league directors before they may compete. Anyone forgetting this form will not be permitted to participate until a completed form is returned.

8. The league commissioners will establish fees each year for the admission to league games and league tournaments.

2022-2023 League Entry Fee: \$400.00

10. The League shall furnish facilities, officials, timer, scorer, scheduling and publicity for originally scheduled games.

11. Games will consist of four (4) six (6) minute quarters. Overtime periods if needed will be three (3) minutes. Following KHSAA rules with exceptions outlined in sections 13, 14, 15, and 16.

12. Hostility among coaches, players, and fans will never be acceptable and is contrary to the ideals, goals, and standards of this league and the organizations in it. Such unlady-like or ungentlemanly conduct will be dealt with in a severe manner by the league directors and commissioners.

First violation shall result with a one LEAGUE game suspension (admission to the gym for that game shall be denied). Second violation shall result in written notification to sponsoring association and <u>suspension</u> until an acceptable resolution is reached between the association and the league to deal with such conduct, and written response is received.

13. When a team no longer has five (5) eligible players to participate in a game, the last eligible player will remain in the game. Any additional fouls committed by that player shall result in a two-shot foul and the offended team will be awarded the ball at mid-court.

14. There will be no full court pressure in the boys divisions when a team is winning by 24 points or 18 points or more in the girls division once the trailing team has clear possession of the ball.

15. When a team is leading by thirty points (30) all *regular* starters shall be removed. **Please abide by the spirit of this rule!**

16. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of the players at all times while on the premises. Games will be played in accordance with the Kentucky High School Athletic Association Rules with the exceptions outlined above. Officials shall be in charge of administering these rules.

17. A team will be permitted ten (10) minutes after scheduled starting time to field five (5) roster players. The game shall start as soon as (5) players are available, if not they shall forfeit that game. Extraordinary circumstances can be declared cause for delay by the league director.

18. This organization strongly suggests that each participant have a physical each year before participating in sports.

19. Once league games are scheduled they will not be changed by the league. If games are changed, it must be resolved in advance and the league notified. The **site director** at the site you are scheduled to play must be notified by Wednesday before (9:00 PM of any changes for that weekend. The game should be played that same day, as scheduled, if at all possible. Any rescheduled game is the responsibility of the two teams to provide a facility and to reschedule. Results must be reported to site director of the location of the original game and the game **must be made up by the following Saturday.** Games may not be changed because of playing in tournaments, etc. It must be a school function, emergency (death, accident etc.).

Should teams fail to show for a game without notifying the appropriate director they shall forfeit game and will be assessed an additional \$50.00 deposit on their entry fee for the following year for every game forfeited.

20. Many teams within this league have the same school colors. Please make sure you have reversible uniforms in case this occurs.
